AYC FAQs

1. What is AYC?

AYC (Audio Youth Camp) is a summer camp that aims to provide inner city youth with hands-on education in music production, engineering, songwriting, and sound design.

2. Is there an age limit to apply?

The age limit to apply is 12-17 years old.

3. How long is the program?

AYC is a three-week intensive day camp held on Wednesdays and Saturdays from 10am-2pm.

4. Is there a bus that gets you close to the location?

Yes, the 31 West End- Evanston Crosstown bus is on the direct line serving Clifton Heights, Desales Corner, Evanston, Fairview, Hughes High School, Lower Price Hill, Peebles Corner, Queensgate, Riverview House, University of Cincinnati, Walnut Hills High School. By Request, we can supply a Metro pass for the duration of the program.

Is lunch provided during the camp?
 Lunch will be provided daily between 12:00 pm and 12:30pm. Lunch will include vegetarian options.

- How many slots are reserved for this camp? 10-15 slots.
- Does the program exist throughout the year? Currently, we offer summer camp only.
- 8. What if my child misses a class? Is there a make-up day?

 There are no make-up days. If there are more than 2 missed absences, the students will be disqualified from the program.
- How does the field trip to Cincinnati Black Music Walk of Fame work?We will have chartered transportation to and from the camp location to the museum..
- 10. Is there a price associated with this summer camp? The camp is 100% free to those accepted.
- 11. What if my child is late to the session?

There is a 20 minute grace period, after which no additional students are permitted into the camp session.

12. How many instructors are there during the camp?

There are two main instructors and 1-2 studio assistants.

- 13. Will this camp happen again next year? Yes.
- 14. What are the requirements to apply?

Must be between the ages of 12-17 and live within the city of Cincinnati. We strongly encourage youth living in these areas to apply:

West End, Bond Hill, Roselawn, Avondale, OTR, Westwood, East & West Price Hill, Winton Hills, and Central Business District.
